TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. USBC tournament rules apply in addition to the following rules.
- Entries will be open to all adult women sanctioned members of the Colorado State USBC. Non-USBC members must buy an unattached membership and bowl scratch. Unattached fee is \$26.00.
- 3. Entrants will use highest 2021/22 USBC book average of 21 games or more. If no 2021/22 USBC average, the bowler will use their highest USBC average of 21 games or more as of November 9th, 2022. If still no average, they must bowl scratch. All averages must be from sanctioned leagues in USBC. Each bowler is responsible for verifying their own average. You must report any average errors prior to the end of the first game.
- 4. USBC Rule 319a will apply to this tournament.
- All Events entry is optional and if selected, scores are taken from the first set of each event.
- 6. An entrant may bowl as many as two Team events and as many as two Doubles events. When submitting multiple Team entries, no more than two players can be duplicated on each entry. When submitting multiple doubles entries, partners must not be duplicated.
- 7. All prize monies will be returned 100% in Team and Doubles at a ratio of 1 in 8. All Events will be returned at a ratio of 1 in 15. Payout will be after average verification has been completed (minimum of 1 week after the completion of the tournament).
 - a. Fee Breakdown:

i. Bowling: \$12.00ii. Prize Fund: \$11.75iii. Expense: \$1.25

- 8. Check in is 30 minutes prior to bowling start time. Late bowlers will receive a 0 score for each frame that they are absent.
- 9. Squad time limits:

a. Team: 3 hoursb. Doubles: 2 hours

- 10. Dress Code: All bowlers must wear a shirt with jeans, slacks or knee length "formal wear" shorts. No athletic wear is allowed. Attire must be clean, free of holes and not contain profanity. No electronic devices or hats will be worn during competition.
- 11. Lanes will be oiled prior to each squad.
- 12. Brackets will be available for each squad.
- 13. Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
