## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- USBC tournament rules apply in addition to the following rules.
- Entries will be open to all adult men sanctioned members of Mesa County USBC. Non-MCUSBC members must buy a membership. (\$15 National, \$2 Colorado, \$9 Mesa County)
- 3. Entrants will use highest 2023/24 USBC book average of 21 games or more. If no 2023/24 USBC average, the bowler will use their highest USBC average of 21 games or more as of January 1st, 2025. If still no average, they must bowl scratch. All averages must be from sanctioned leagues in USBC. Each bowler is responsible for verifying their own average.
- 4. USBC Rule 319a will apply to this tournament.
- 5. All Events entry is optional and if selected, scores are taken from the first set of each event. Entry fee is returned in prize fund 100%.
- 6. An entrant may bowl as many as two Team events and as many as two Doubles events, but only bowl Singles once. When submitting multiple team entries, no more than two players can be duplicated on each entry. When submitting multiple doubles entries, partners must not be duplicated. The first doubles entry must also bowl singles.
- 7. All prize monies will be returned 100% at a ratio of 1 in 8. Payout will be after average verification has been completed (minimum of 1 week after the completion of the tournament).
  - a. Fee Breakdown:

i. Bowling: \$12.00ii. Prize Fund: \$11.75iii. Expense: \$1.25

- 8. Check in will close 30 minutes prior to bowling start time. Late bowlers will receive a 0 score for each frame that they are absent.
- 9. Squad time limits:

a. Team: 3 hoursb. Doubles: 2 hoursc. Singles: 2 hours

- 10. Dress Code: All bowlers must wear a shirt with jeans, slacks or knee length "formal wear" shorts. No athletic wear is allowed. Attire must be clean, free of holes and not contain profanity. No electronic devices will be worn during competition.
- 11. Divisions are defined as follows:
  - a. Singles / Hdcp All Events
    - i. Classified, 200 avg and below
    - ii. Regular, 201 avg and above
  - b. Doubles
    - i. Classified, 400 avg and below
    - ii. Regular, 401 avg and above
  - c. Team
    - i. Classified, 800 avg and below
    - ii. Regular, 801 avg and above
- 12. Lanes will be oiled prior to each squad.
- 13. Brackets will be available for each squad.
- 14. Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless written appeal is filed USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
- 15. Tournament officials may terminate or suspend the play of any participant causing unreasonable delays, disorderly conduct, or otherwise violating the code of conduct of the Facility. Tournament officials have sole and absolute discretion to accept or reject any entry of a participant in the Tournament. All decisions of Tournament officials are final, binding and non-appealable.
